Weather and Field Conditions

Temperatures ranged from 28-34 degrees (F), with considerable overcast early to mid-day, partly sunny skies by late afternoon. Winds were pleasantly calm and there was no precipitation on count day. Major bodies of water were open and calm; moving streams and creeks were running strong and high, creating inhospitable conditions in all but a few backwaters. Smaller ponds, lakes, and reservoirs were largely frozen. Cornfields were predominantly covered with a thin layer of snow encased in a hard, icy crust. No waterfowl were observed in traditionally productive fields.

Temperatures during the week preceding the count were generally above average, with extreme highs of 58° F on 13 January and 62° F on 14 January.
